ARE YOU LISTENING?REALLY LISTENING?

In the still of the night? In the early morning? In the busyness of the day? While you're watching a football game or eating?

Watch! Be alert! That's what he said to us.

"What I say to you, I say to everyone: 'Watch!" (Mark 13:37 NIV)

"...keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come (Matthew 24:42 NIV)." Jesus even compared his return to the surprise of a thief coming to a house. If the owner of the house had known at what time the thief was coming, he would have kept watch and not let his house be broken into. So by parallel, we must be ready and watch for Jesus' return.

True, we don't know the specific hour or day. But we do know it is soon and imminent. In newsletters over the past several months we have talked about aspects of this return. In television programs and several CD's, we have looked at the many prophecies relating to his return that have now been fulfilled.

Jesus made the point that we should be aware his return is imminent. He pointed to the fig tree and how, when we observe its twigs getting tender and its leaves coming out, we know summer is near. Well, when we see all the prophesied events to happen just before he returns actually having happened, we know it is near, right at the door. Further, the generation that is alive when the prophecies are fulfilled will see that return (Matthew 24:32-34, Mark 13:28-30 NIV). Well, we have seen those prophecies fulfilled. People are alive today who were alive when the nation of Israel was reborn in 1948, when Jerusalem was taken over by the Jews again in 1967. And all the other prophecies fulfilled in the intervening years.

Watch! Be alert!

Paul described what will happen very clearly: "For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air... (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 NIV)."

Paul gives the warning – "...let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be alert and self controlled (1 Thessalonians 5:6 NIV)." And Paul makes the encouraging statement – "God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thessalonians 5:9 NIV)." We who believe are not supposed to suffer the great wrath that comes on the earth in the period called the tribulation. No, we are supposed to go with Jesus beforehand.

Jesus himself gives the great warning: "Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man (Luke 21:36 NIV)."

So be alert! Watch! Keep your eyes on Jesus. Make sure you are in the right relationship with him.

Ecclesia means called out, a group of people called out. Called out from the world, then. Really, and I love this definition, ecclesia means a group of people called out to a new society of which Jesus is the head. He is the head. He is the king of this new society.

The CHURCH of Jesus is not a particular denomination or building. It is not buildings at all. People today who truly believe in Jesus and who have him as their Lord are part of that CHURCH. That's true if they live in the US or Russia or Africa or Saipan or wherever. It's true if they are members of a particular denomination or if they aren't, and if they go on Sunday mornings to a service at a particular church building or not. The key is that they know Jesus and are therefore part of the CHURCH, part of the Kingdom.

Jesus is coming to call out his CHURCH. That's who he is coming to collect.

Always keep your eyes on Jesus, as the banner on our office wall says. Make sure you are in the right relationship with the Lord. Don't be distracted by all the confusion of the world system which is spiraling into the ground daily. Yes, you need to pay attention to the news events.
